II. LAND TRUST PRESENTATION,

Camille Reynolds Lewis, Executive Director, Hannibal Square Community Land Trust provided information on the history and purpose of Community Land Trusts. The Hannibal Square CLT was established in 2004 in Winter Park and expanded in 2016 to service Orange, Lake, Osceola, and Seminole Counties. It is a nonprofit, member-based corporation that holds community land in-kind, which makes homeownership more affordable. The CLT is governed by a Board of Directors. One board member is usually a homeowner in the CLT.

R. Dixon provided updates on the MSTU and CRA Maintenance Programs. He also discussed several issues of concern with the Blue Diamond USA (BDUSA) Project. To move forward, BDUSA must provide a clear and accurate timeline, expenditure documentation, and must secure future investments. **V.Pinkney** established an August 15 deadline for BDUSA to state their intentions. OBT Development Board will continue with BDUSA if all obligations are met. If not, we are prepared to continue with Catalyst 1955, LLC and move in a different direction.
